RE-ENROLLMENT FOR 2010/2011 SCHOOL YEAR – UNDERWAY NOW!

Yes, it's that time of the year already!!! Re-enrollment packets are available at the school office during the normal hours of the regular school day. Everyone should plan to come and pick up their forms, as they will not be mailed out this year.

Enrollment Incentive:

Time is running out on a brand new financial incentive for the 2010-2011 school year! Tuition is set to go up by \$300.00 per child for the 2010-2011 school year. However, if you re-enroll and your enrollment fee is paid before March 1, 2010, you can lock in the current rate for next year. On March 1, 2010, the new tuition rate will apply for all students. Please keep this discount in mind as you consider re-enrollment for next year.

Enrollment Fees:

Enrollments are complete when the \$100.00 registration fee is paid. Remember, the enrollment fee is \$100.00 as long as it is submitted before March 1, 2010. On March 1, the enrollment fee jumps to \$150.00 per student. In addition, the enrollment fee jumps again to \$200.00 after May 15.

Financial Aid Information:

Also, if you want to apply for scholarships for next school year, you must complete a Financial Aid Application form. We will be using a new financial aid resource company called N.A.I.S. This company uses a form called the "School and Student Services" (S.S.S.) form that helps to determine your complete financial picture which helps show financial need. This company replaces T.A.D.S. for financial aid evaluation. This form must be completed by April 1, 2010 and can be found on the CLS website under the "Enrollment/Financial Aid" page. Please visit www.clssp.org for more information regarding the financial aid process. These forms will also be available during re-enrollment.

This year, payment options include the following:

- Monthly payments through VANCO (our online automatic bill payment program)
- Quarterly, Semi-Annual, and Annual payments to the office.

Let's see if we can work together to get the enrollment done early this year! Thank you!

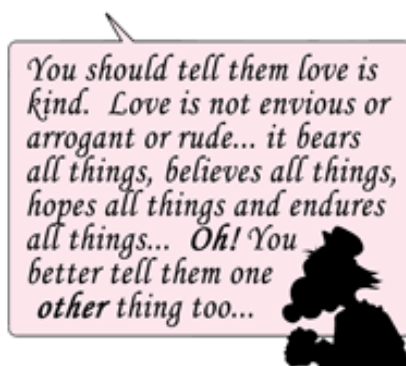
